

WHITE AND GOLD

TRADITION, WINE, AND CULTURE IN THE VILLAGES OF CÁDIZ.

Day 1 – DEPARTURE POINT – HOTEL

Departure from the departure point toward Andalusia, an autonomous region known for its rich history, cultural diversity, and spectacular landscapes. Lunch en route at your own expense. Continue to the hotel. DINNER and OVERNIGHT STAY.

Day 2 – CÁDIZ – ROTA

BREAKFAST and departure for CÁDIZ, a sun-drenched coastal city that Lord Byron described as “The Siren of the Ocean.” Popularly known as “La Tacita de Plata” (the silver cup). Includes a guided tour with a local guide. Lunch at your own expense. In the afternoon, we’ll take a leisurely stroll through ROTA. Since the time of the Phoenicians, ROTA has been a trading port, and numerous Roman ruins have been found in the surrounding area. Designated a historic site, this small town—with its ancient arches, narrow streets lined with white houses, and beautiful squares and picturesque corners—defines the character of this lovely place. Return to the hotel for DINNER and OVERNIGHT STAY.

Day 3 – JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA – ARCOS DE LA FRONTERA

Breakfast followed by a visit to JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA, whose most significant Andalusian heritage site is the Alcázar de Jerez fortress. Within the city walls lie the mosque, the Arab baths, and the Garden of Olive Trees with its pools and fountains, which harmonize perfectly with the Baroque Palace of Villavicencio, built on the ruins of the original Islamic palace; in its tower, visitors can view the original camera obscura. Also noteworthy is the cathedral, a beautiful Baroque building of great monumentality. Lunch at your own expense. At the time agreed upon by our tour guide, we will drive to ARCOS DE LA FRONTERA, the gateway to the white villages of the province of Cádiz and one of the most beautiful and scenic villages in Andalusia. Return to the hotel for DINNER and OVERNIGHT STAY.

Day 4 – SANLÚCAR DE BARRAMEDA – CHIPIONA

Breakfast and departure for SANLÚCAR DE BARRAMEDA, a town with a stately atmosphere that has been designated a historic site and whose urban layout is characterized by two main districts: the Barrio Alto and the Barrio Bajo. The Barrio Alto is the historic and monumental center with narrow streets, white facades, and aristocratic palaces such as the Palacio de Orleans y Borbón or the Renaissance-style Palacio Ducal de Medina Sidonia. To enjoy tapas in Sanlúcar, there’s no better place than Plaza Cabildo or Bajo de Guía, the fishing district with its many restaurants where you can sample the famous shrimp, small fish, and seafood dishes. From its pier, the “Real Fernando” departs, sailing up the river to its mouth to explore Doñana. Optionally, you can take a boat trip on the Guadalquivir River to DOÑANA NATIONAL PARK, where we’ll disembark to explore, with a guide, the village of LA PLANCHA, the huts in the pine forest, and the plains of La Plancha—places where the wildlife of Doñana National Park is frequently spotted. Lunch at your own expense. We continue to CHIPIONA, a historic town whose 13th-century castle serves as a coastal fortress and whose church, Nuestra Señora de la O, located in the heart of Chipiona’s old town, houses an extremely interesting collection of religious art. The lighthouse is considered the tallest in Spain and one of the tallest in the world. Return to the hotel for DINNER and OVERNIGHT STAY.

Day 5 – JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA “ALMA DE JEREZ SPECIAL”

BREAKFAST. Free time at the hotel, and anyone who wishes may optionally take a full-day excursion to the beautiful city of Jerez de la Frontera, where we can enjoy the “ALMA DE JEREZ” package. We begin the visit with the horse show “COMO BAILAN LOS CABALLOS ANDALUCES” (How Andalusian Horses Dance) at the Royal Riding School of Jerez de la Frontera. Afterward, we visit the famous BODEGA ALVARO DOMECQ winery, where we tour the facilities and enjoy a WINE TASTING. Then we head to a TABLAO FLAMENCO, where we enjoy lunch with typical tapas from Granada (included in the package). After lunch, we’ll experience a live FLAMENCO SHOW: PURE ART. Return to the hotel for DINNER and OVERNIGHT STAY.

Day 6 – RETURN TRIP

BREAKFAST, then return to the departure point at the scheduled time. Lunch en route at your own expense.
