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ITINERARY

DAY 1 – DEPARTURE POINT – GRANADA

Departure for Granada; lunch en route at your own expense. Continue to the hotel; check-in. In the afternoon, those interested may join a guided tour with a local guide through the city of Granada, which lies at the foot of the Sierra Nevada between the rivers Darro and Genil and is one of the most interesting cities in Eastern Andalusia. The impressive heritage of the Andalusians is complemented by architectural gems of the Renaissance and state-of-the-art facilities of the 21st century. Dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 2 GRANADA – ALMA DE GRANADA PACKAGE – GRANADA

Breakfast at the hotel. Optionally, we can visit the Alhambra in Granada accompanied by a local tour guide. The complex consists of beautiful rectangular courtyards and numerous fountains, as well as the Nasrid buildings, which served as residences for the kings and their servants. After the tour, we'll take the tourist train for a scenic ride through the city's most significant Landmarks (the tourist train can be used as often as desired throughout the day. Arrival at the flamenco venue, where we can enjoy a typical Granada tapas lunch and a flamenco show. At the end of the day, return to the hotel, dinner, and overnight stay.

DAY 3 GRANADA – ALPUJARRAS GRANADINAS – GRANADA

Breakfast at the hotel. We offer a wonderful full-day excursion to the Alpujarras Granadinas, a region of rugged mountains, deep valleys, high peaks, narrow paths, and gorges. We will admire villages with a distinctly Arab flair, featuring narrow, steep alleys that cling to the mountainside. We will visit Soportújar, Capileira, and Pampaneira. Soportújar is known as the village of witches, while Capileira preserves its traditional architecture with white houses and flat roofs in winding alleys; Pampaneira is considered the most beautiful village in the Alpujarra. Lunch at your own expense. Return to Granada. Dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 4 GRANADA – CARTAGENA LICOR 43 FACTORY – PLACE OF PRODUCTION

Breakfast followed by departure to Cartagena to visit the Licor 43 factory, where we will taste Licor 43, take a tour of the museum to learn about its history, enjoy a cocktail show with two appetizers (one sweet and one savory), and finally sample some of the varieties of the famous Licor 43. After the visit, we continue our route to the place of origin.
